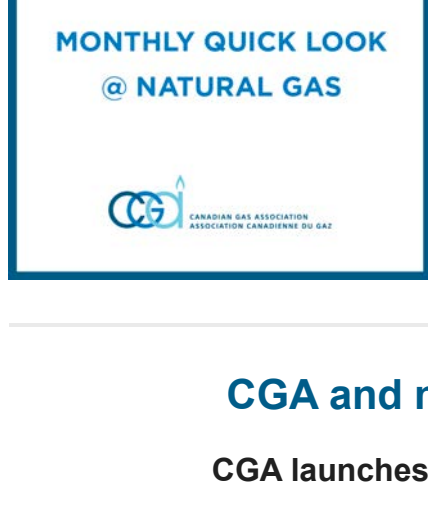

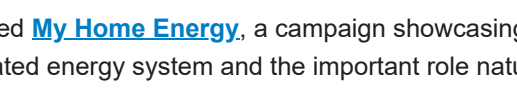

Watch EWI's polymer welding technical webinar



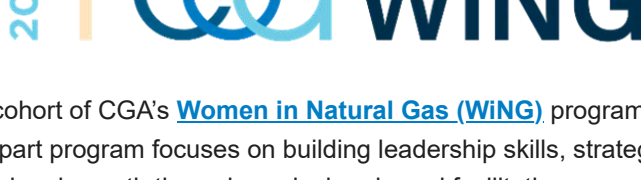

CGA WiNG: Sponsor and champion the future of energy leadership

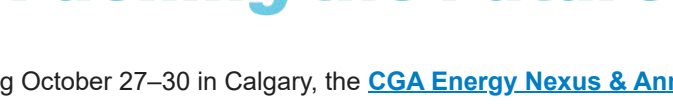

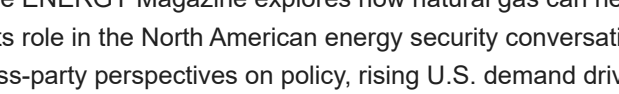
